COMPETITION FORMAT:

- Two magazines will be required to compete
- · Rounds: One 50-shot round
- · Scoring: Range manager will score at the end of the round
- Winner: Top three shooters with the highest scores win the cash*
 *Tie-breaker: Shooter with the most X's will be declared the winner

PRIZES: 80% payout of kitty fee to the top 3 winners (value depends on the number of entrants)

1 st Place 6	80%
2 nd Place	15%

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- Range Fee: Members are exempt from range fees for league shooting.
 Non-members are required to pay the guest range fee and must sign a waiver prior to participation.
- · Limited Space: Pre-registration suggested
- Check-In: 20 minutes prior to assigned shooting time or spot may be given to another shooter
- Open Practice: 30 minutes prior to shooting time on the digital range

RANGE RULES

- Safety First: Always prioritize safety.
 Follow all range safety rules, including
 wearing eye and ear protection, keeping
 the firearm pointed in a safe direction,
 and keeping your finger off the trigger
 until ready to shoot.
- 2. Firearm Handling: Firearms should be unloaded and cased when not on the firing line. Only handle firearms at the designated firing line or in designated safe areas
- 3. Ammunition: Use only approved ammunition purchased from the store the night of the shoot.
- 4. Shooting Positions: All shooting mus be done from the designated firing positions. Cross-lane shooting is not allowed. No drawing from the hip.
- 5. Targets: Targets will be provided at the beginning of each league night.
- 6. Range Qualification: Participants may need to demonstrate proficiency and safe handling of their firearm before being allowed to shoot in the league.
- 7. Scoring and Matches: Matches are typically scored based on accuracy and time. The specific courses of fire and scoring methods can vary by league.
- 8. Cleanliness: Participants are responsible for cleaning up their shooting area, including picking up brass and disposing of targets.
- Prohibited Items: Drugs and alcohol are strictly prohibited on the range. No one under the influence of drugs or alcohol is allowed to participate.
- 10. Proper Dress Code: Shoes must be worn no open toes.
